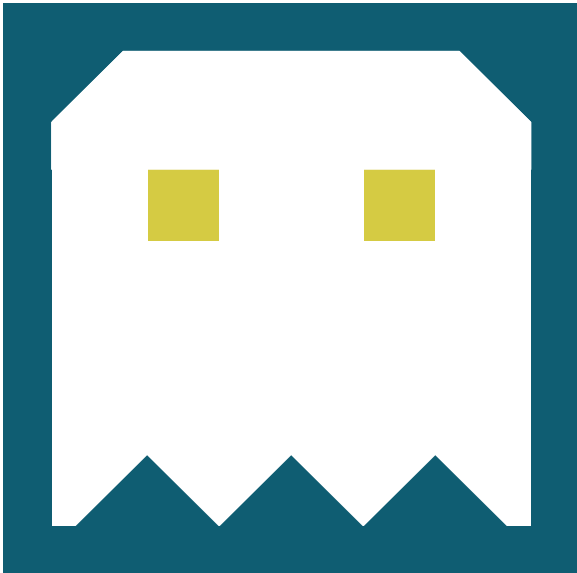


GHOSTLY BOO



BLOCK DETAILS

- Block size: 12" Finished
- Difficulty level: Beginner
- Machine Pieced

Cutting Instructions - Below are the cutting instructions and directions to make ONE ghost block that finishes at 12" square.

From the NAVY background Fabric, cut the following;

- (x2) 2" squares
- (x3) 3½" x 2" rectangles
- (x2) 10½" x 1½" rectangles
- (x2) 12½" x 1½" rectangles

From the WHITE Ghost fabric, cut the following;

- (x1) 10½" x 3" rectangle
- (x1) 10½" x 5" rectangle
- (x2) 2½" x 2" rectangles
- (x1) 3½" x 2" rectangle
- (x2) 1" x 2" rectangles
- (x6) 2" squares

From the Yellow eye Fabrics, cut the following;

- (x2) 2" squares

PREPARING THE PIECES

TRIMMED RECTANGLE - MAKE ONE PER GHOST BLOCK

STEP 1 - Draw a line diagonally across each of the two 2" background squares.

STEP 2 - Place these squares in the top corners of the white 10½" x 3" rectangle so that the drawn lines run in the same direction as fig 1.

STEP 3 - Sew along the diagonal line and then trim the excess fabric ¼" from the sewn line.

STEP 4 - Fold out the triangles and press to finish.

FLYING GEESE UNITS - MAKE THREE PER GHOST BLOCK

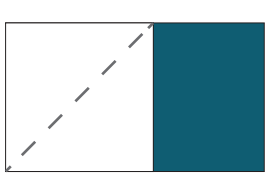

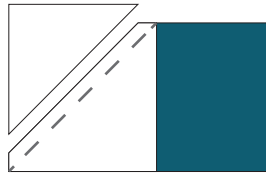

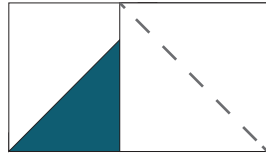

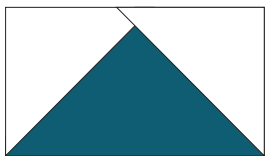

STEP 5 - Draw a line diagonally across each of the two 2" white squares.

STEP 6 - Place the first square to the left hand side of the background 3 1/2" x 2" rectangle, making sure the line runs in the same direction as fig 4.

STEP 7 - Sew along the diagonal line and then trim the excess fabric 1/4" from the sewn line. fig 5

STEP 8 - Fold out the triangle and press. fig 6

STEP 9 - Place the second square on the right hand side of the 3 1/2" x 2" background rectangle and repeat steps 7 and 8.

STEP 10 - Fold out the triangle and press to finish.

PIECING THE ROWS

STEP 11 - Sew together the pieces below to create the eye section. fig 9

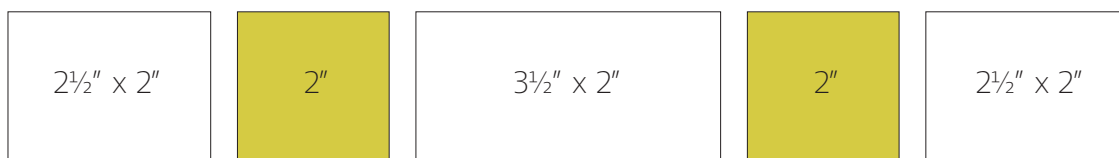

STEP 12 - Sew together the three flying geese units and add a 1" x 2" white rectangle to each end. Fig 10.

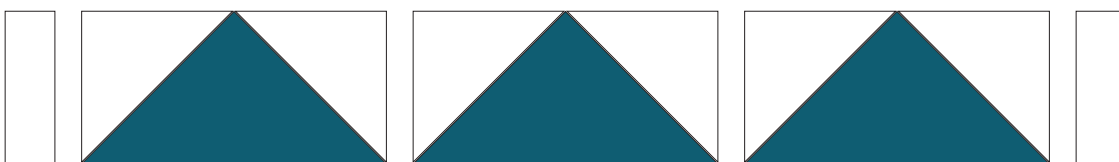
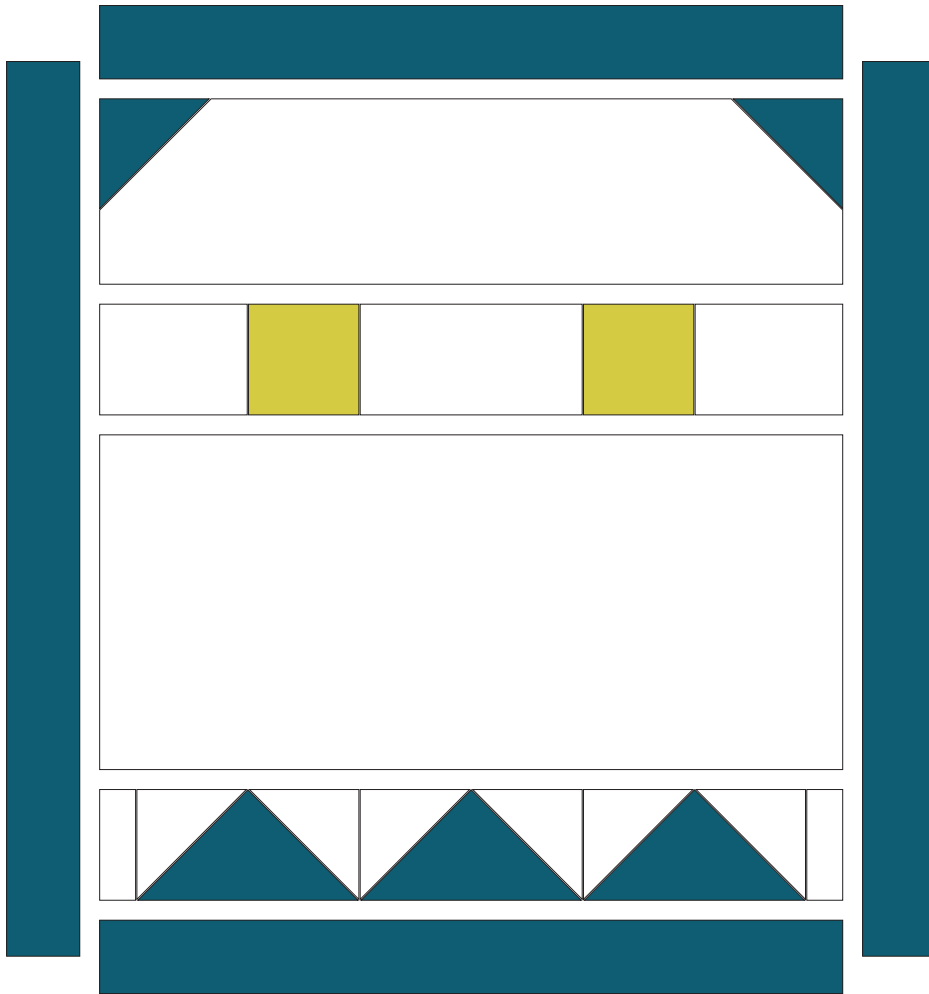

CONSTRUCTING THE GHOST



STEP 13 - Sew together the four rows (Trimmed rectangle, eye row, $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5" white rectangle, flying geese row) that make the centre ghost.

STEP 14 - Sew a $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the top and bottom of the block.

STEP 15 - Sew a $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to each side of the block to complete the border.
